
YAKIMA ROOF TOP TENT COMPATIBILITY GUIDE



STEP 4

VEHICLE ROOF LOAD RATING

Check your vehicle's roof load rating to ensure it can safely support your roof racks and a rooftop tent. You'll find this information in your owner's manual or by contacting the vehicle manufacturer. Load ratings depend on several factors, including your vehicle's roof capacity, the rack system, tent weight, and on-road or off-road usage limits. Always follow the lowest-rated component.
